CHAMELEON Open Call #1 FAQs

Q: Can I submit more than one proposal?

A: Up to two proposals per applicant (company/entity) will be considered for evaluation (the first two to be submitted). After the evaluation only the best one will be accepted for funding (if any).

Q: In what language should I write my proposal?

A: CHAMELEON will only consider documents written in English. Any other language will not be considered for evaluation.

Q: Is my company's country eligible for the CHAMELEON Open Call programme?

A: CHAMELEON Open Calls are available for all the countries associated with the Horizon Europe programme.

Q: How many phases will this Open Call have?

A: CHAMELEON Open Call programme will be divided in two different phases:

- OC #1 for bundle development to the CHAMELEON platform
- OC #2 for pilot use cases for the CHAMELEON solutions

Q: What support will I have during the sub-project execution?

A: A partner from the CHAMELEON consortium will be assigned to each sub-project as a mentor. The mentor will have the role of being the first point of contact for support, monitor the development of the assigned sub-projects and validate the quality of the submitted deliverables.

Q: Can I apply to be an evaluator for the CHAMELEON Open Calls?

A: Yes. Interested experts must comply to the guidelines defined in the Guide for Experts available here [link]. To express their interest, experts must fill in the required form available here [link] and upload the CV.
